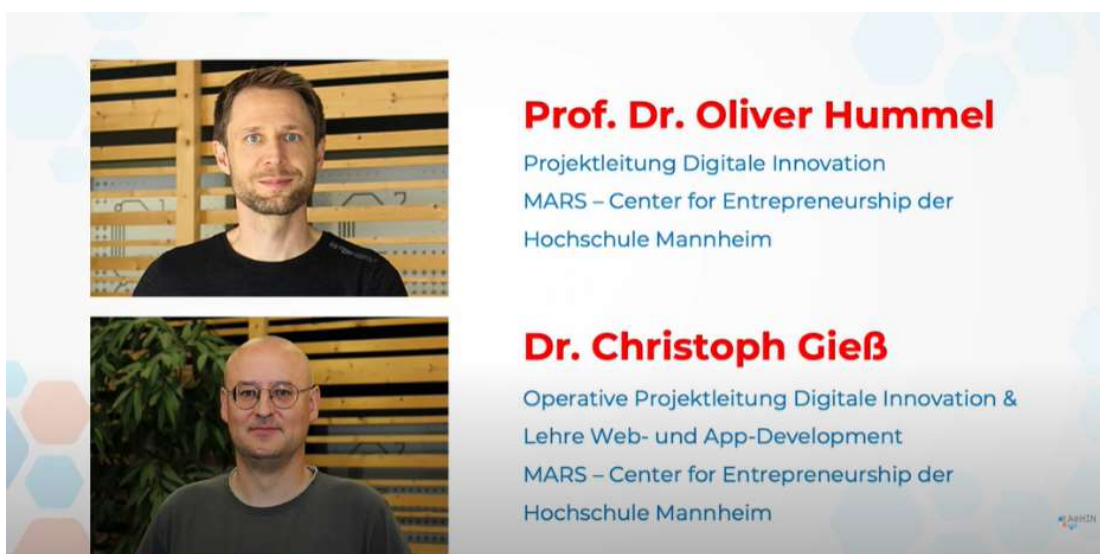

Toumai community webinar: "openIMIS Focal Point: Capacity Building Materials - Training of Trainers"

As part of the webinar series organized by our French community on technologies and social protection, another webinar was held on the 21st of June. Participants were treated to very engaging presentations from 2 members of our "Communauté Toumai", Daniella Majakari from Swiss TPH and Claudia Kebefa from the HIV user fee exemption program in Cameroon.

The first part of the webinar introduced the generic approach of openIMS as a focal point in a country. A review of capacity building materials for openIMIS was done and the webinar was concluded with the presentation of an example and experience sharing from the HIV fee exemption program in Cameroon.
