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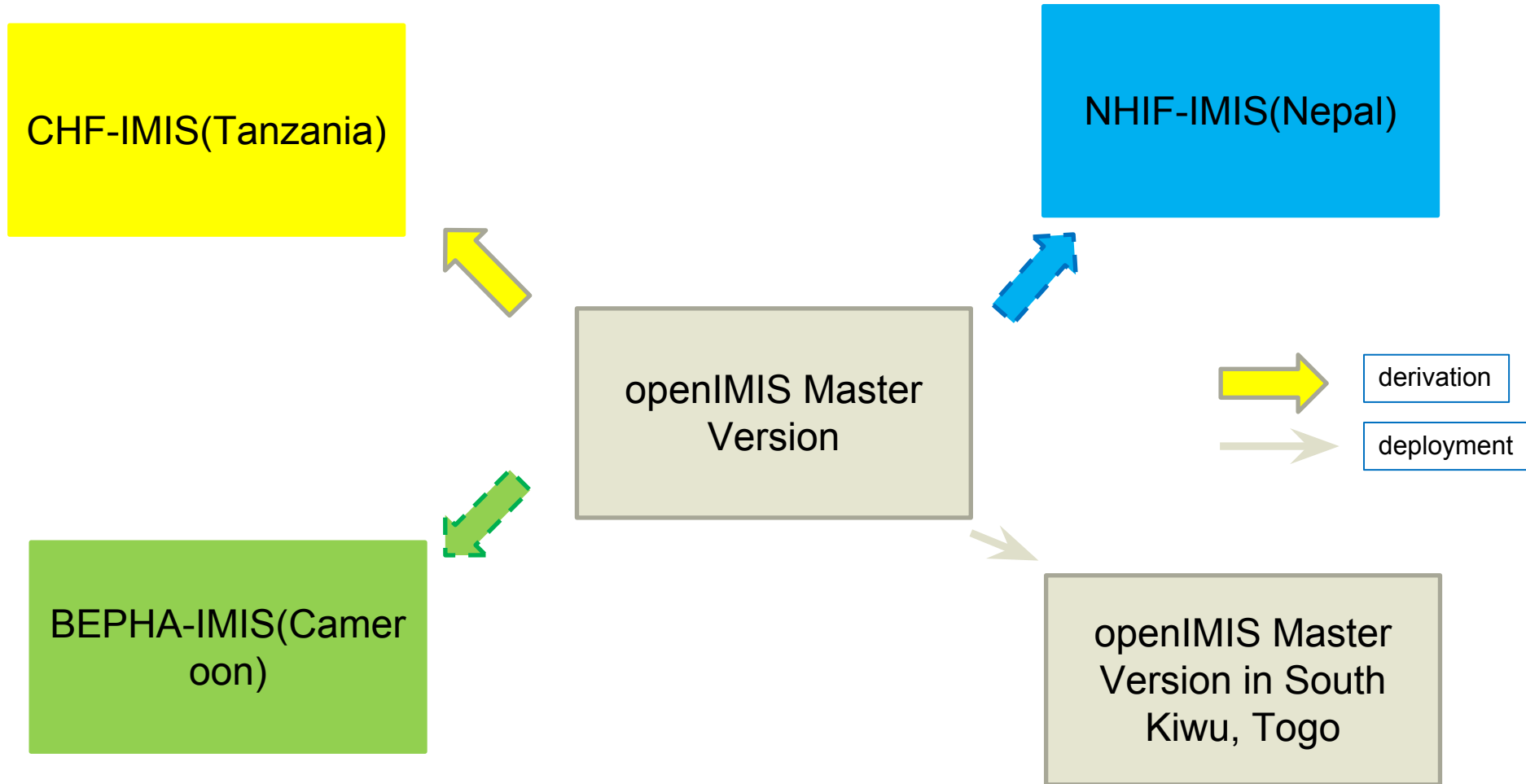

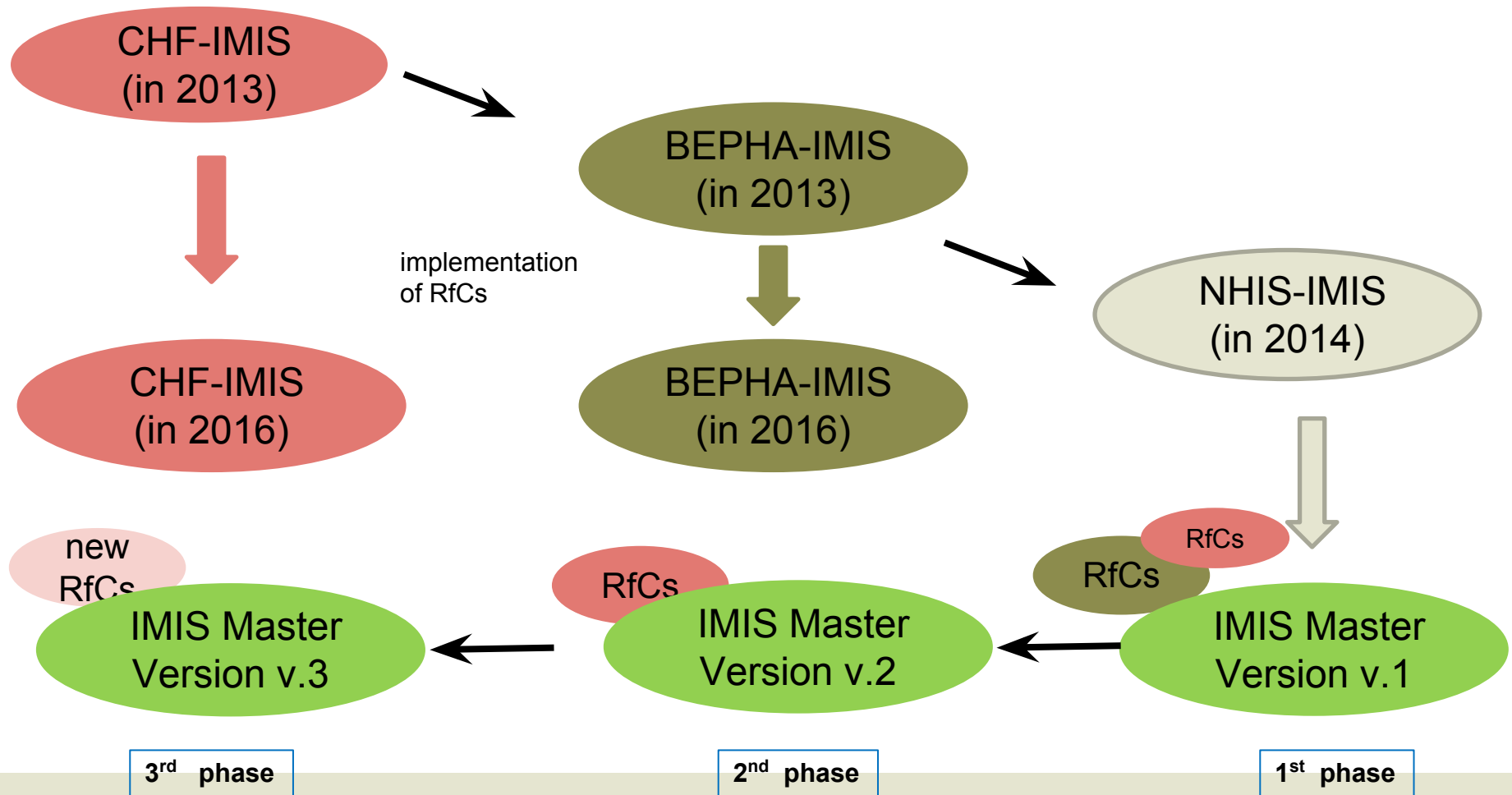

Process of creating of the Master Version





Derivation of a country specific version

A country specific version of IMIS may differ from the Master Version in:

- a) English titles, headings and labels of data fields in user forms and reports-defined in resource files
- b) Titles, headings and labels of data fields in an alternate language in user forms and reports-defined in resource files
- c) Items in drop down lists-defined in parametrization database tables
- d) Presence and/or of some data fields in user interface-defined in parametrization database tables
- e) Isolated pieces of functionality-e.g. checking of format of an insurance number, accessing of a SMS portal, sending e-mails-defined by means of escape procedures



Development of the Master Version

- “Open source” IMIS should be developed and maintained in the form of the Master Version
- Some users may “fork” to their specific versions but they cannot benefit from mutual enhancement of “Open source” IMIS
- Country specific versions deviate from the Master Version only to a defined and limited extent in the presentation layer
- Differences in business logic layer are only in different implementation of escape procedures. The rest is common for all country specific versions.
- Database layers are common for all country specific versions.
- It means that the vast majority of requirements for fixing an error and the vast majority of requirements for a change are directed towards the Master Version



Status of the openMIS Master Version

openMIS - Master Version – release 17.5.14

- regional level of insurance products (besides district and national levels)
- support of capitation payment
- specification of catchments areas of health facilities
- detailed specification of the field of activity of enrolment officers (up to a village)
- comprehensive mobile phone appk for enrolment officers
- moving of territorial units
- bilingual - English, French
- minor enhancement



Status of country specific versions

- CHF-IMIS – release 17.5.4 derived from the Master Version
 - using of mobile phone appks (around 2300 users)
 - using in three provinces
- BEPHA-IMIS – release from 2016 not yet derived from the Master Version –planned for spring 2018
 - mobile phone appks not used yet
 - used for the whole insurance scheme
- NHIF-IMIS – release from 2016, the status relating to the Master Version – not known but ready to start
 - mobile phone appks are used
