



Topics to consider/Challenges

- Choice of upload?
 - Excel
 - CSV flat file or others (XML?)
 - Combinations of import formats?
- In case an entity is uploaded than strong validation procedures must be in place
 - E.g. Health facility can only have a Legal form that exists.
 - E.g. An insureee can only have a profession that is in the list of Professions and must belong to an existing Head of family
- One to Many relationship (e.g. HF and Catchment area) → What is the best upload media?: Excel, CSV, XML?
- What about imports that have partially succeeded (commit or rollback?)
 - If not successful, what sort of report we process for follow up?
- Import only in certain **sequence** for mass upload of more than 1 entity
- Follow business rules for inserts and updates (e.g. Legacy record inserts)

Topics to consider/Challenges....continued

•What about imports that include already uploaded records amongst new ones

Overwrite existing records and amend new ones

Provide perhaps an option how to import

Amend new records only

Amend and Update existing records

Amend and Update and Delete

Full commit only vs. partial success

- •Provide an excel template for each upload with possible some BL in it?
 - Mandatory fields (highlighted)
 - Masking of fields with custom mask
 - Numbers only
 - Max text length
 - Allows 3 characters etc...
 - Combo boxes for restricted options
- •Upload provided with **codes** but inserted with Ids in the database as PK (Primary Key).
- Exceptions found in uniqueness of record (Code)
 - •e.g. Payers. Another verification needed uniqueness
