Contribute to the gradual inclusion of hitherto excluded populations into social health protection schemes by improving the schemes' data and information management capacities through the use of openIMIS



Ensure that existing capacity development and implementation starter kit related resources are brought together and structured into an online course


- Making an inventory of what capacity building material already exists (directory)





- Utilize the software in there own setting(s) (applying)
- Examine the pros and cons of openIMIS (analyzing)
- Recommend openIMIS to their managers (evaluating)
