		<p>OpenIMIS is the first open source software supporting the management of social (health) protection schemes...and linking beneficiaries, providers and payer data.</p> <p>It is a powerful tool to strengthen strategic purchasing of health services and digital processing of health system data.</p>
		openIMIS is free to download... customize... and share
		<p>Its compatible with various schemes and interfaces for data exchange.</p> <p>It easily adaptable to the stakeholders needs.</p>
		It is a sustainable initiative driven by the openIMIS community that promotes exchange at the global level.

	<p>Show map of Tanzania with institutions popping as they are named.</p> <p>Show the acronym on screen only when names are said (IMIS), SDC, Swiss TPD; CHF</p>	<p>Back then the Swiss Agency for Development Cooperation , Swiss TPH along with the Microinsurance Academy and Exact Software developed an Insurance Management Information System to operate community health funds in several districts of Tanzania.</p>
