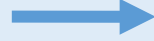

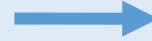

Data saved on a local server

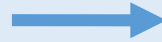
*Step 1 can be done at health facility level, as patient registration prior to treatment

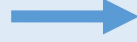
HEALTH SERVICE



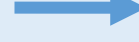
Patient visits health facility

Patient treatment



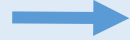
Services entered into openIMIS claim form

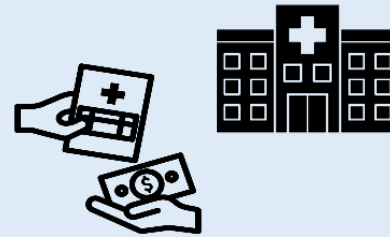
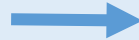
CLAIMS MANAGEMENT

- Benefit package (services and prices)
- Contracted providers
- Service claims and reimbursement

STRATEGIC PURCHASING MADE POSSIBLE

openMIS is flexible and customizable for health systems moving towards UHC and strategic purchasing of services.
